The 100 Club of Buffalo, Inc. is an independent, non-profit, non-political organization thats sole purpose is to provide services to the members of local law enforcement, fire services and emergency medical services (EMS), both paid and volunteer, and their families.



When funeral and burial arrangements must be made at the time of death, rather than having been pre-arranged, grieving families must make difficult decisions during a time of stress and emotional exhaustion. In addition, the cemeteries provide a 10% discount on burial space to the surviving spouse if and when arrangements are made for their services, either pre-need or at-need.

CEMETERY SPACE

By New York State Law, The 100 Club Funeral and Burial Funds can be used only for burial space. It does not include Interment Service Fees. These fees vary from cemetery to cemetery and generally increase annually. The 100 Club gives money to the family of the deceased that can be used to cover these costs. Depending upon the type of final disposition chosen, service fees for interments may include:

- Grave opening and closing (approximately \$1,300)
- Crypt entombment (approximately \$1,200)
- Niche opening (approximately \$700)
